STUDENT ADMISSIONS POLICY STATEMENT

- Each potential student will be assessed at interview on the basis of certificated academic achievement thus far, academic potential and motivation; extenuating circumstances will, of course, also be taken into account.
- Cardiff Academy aims to ensure that its student admissions process is both fair and transparently free from all forms of discrimination.
- The Academy will ensure there is no differential application of the Policy.
- More specifically, there will be no discrimination as regards student admissions on the grounds of ethnic/national origin, culture, religion, gender, disability or sexual orientation.

DISABILITY STATEMENT

Cardiff Academy is pleased to consider applications from disabled students. Such applicants will be considered on an individual basis as regards the feasibility of The Academy being able to meet their specific support needs. For example, one major problem facing wheelchair users is the absence of toilet facilities on the Ground Floor.

SPECIAL NEEDS STATEMENT

Cardiff Academy is pleased to consider applications from students with special needs. Such applicants will be considered on an individual basis as regards the feasibility of The Academy being able to meet their specific support requirements. More specifically, The Academy has accepted many students over the years with a dyslexia statement/report from the Dyslexia Institute. We are used to working closely with such students and with the Institute, especially given its close proximity to Cardiff Academy on City Road.
